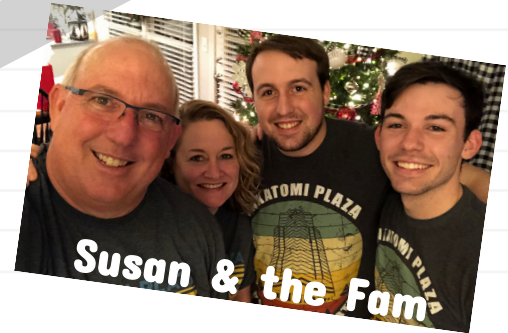

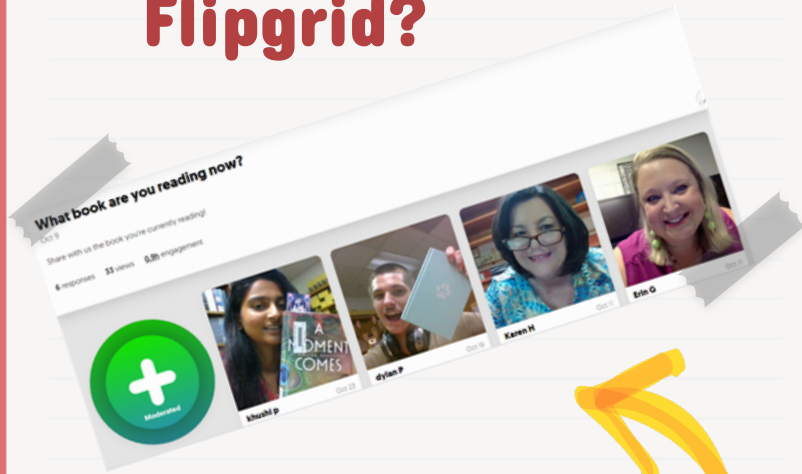

What Is Flipgrid?



- Platform to create topics and groups of topics
- Students post video responses
- Teachers can share informational videos
- Protected, creative platform for students to express themselves
- Utilizes Microsoft Logins
- Integrates with MS Teams
