The full version of Popplet (not this version) lets you create an unlimited number of local popplets, which are stored on your iPad. You can also use the full version to create online popplets, which can be shared with and edited by other Popplet users, both on the web at [popplet.com](http://popplet.com) and on their iPads.

### Suggestion:

In order to use the Popplet Lite Version, practice this procedure with students:

- Create a popplet
- Add your name to the popplet to identify your work and use only your first name [Internet Safety Practice]
- Save the popplet to the photo gallery
- Email your popplet to the teacher with your class email account.
- Delete your Popplet for the next person using the Clear All button

Warning - Working with the free account, students will not be able to return to edit the file.
